I find it hard to believe that this proposal can be considered on the information provided. It is vague at best, with no details of proposed access to the site.

This leads to new speculation that access could be via Delbush or Burdell Avenue - totally unacceptable, given it crosses a bridleway/footpath. Access via Hawkes Close also unacceptable, leading onto Bayswater Road - poor visibility onto already congested roads

If both these accesses are used, this will amount to a horrendous rat-run occurring.

The loss of the green belt area for the sake of profit and its environmental consequences is unacceptable.

I thought last year the proposed development was rejected by Councillors . Given the vast support to reject the proposal, surely if democracy works it should be refused.
