Scrutiny Committee

The committee met on 6 March to discuss a review of the planning enforcement statement. The committee noted the report and the progress made and thanked the enforcement team for their work. Comments were made on where it was felt the process could be improved but the committee did not suggest any changes to the statement at this time. Instead, the committee asked officers to consider increasing the range of points that could be awarded in relation to the scale of the breach of planning conditions and to the degree of planning harm.

The committee suggested that after the district council elections in May, the new Scrutiny Committee considers calling for a further progress review of the new planning enforcement statement approach in around nine months' time, which could be at the committee's meeting in November.
