Recommendation

To make no change to the boundary between Wallingford and Crowmarsh Gifford parishes

Justification

The current boundary makes little sense in a modern context but has historical significance. The River Thames would provide a strong natural boundary but given Wallingford town council's strong support for the existing boundary the working group considers that things are best left as they are. There are no properties within the area under consideration so issues of identity and convenient representation are largely irrelevant.
