Conditions to be agreed

Thames Valley Police have a historic record of anti social behaviour in the area of 31 Elm Drive, Garsington.

Due to this we would like the following conditions attached to the licence:

All alcoholic spirits to be kept behind the counter(as stated in plan). The remaining alcohol to be kept within viewing distance of the counter and not near the entrance of the premise.

The Premise shall adopt a challenge 21 policy. All members of staff at the premises shall seek "credible photographic proof of age evidence" from any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years and who is seeking to purchase or consume alcohol on the premises. Such credible evidence, which shall include a photograph of the customer, will either be a passport or photographic driving licence.

The CCTV system shall incorporate a recording facility which shall be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of one calendar month. The system will comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and all signs as required will be clearly displayed. The system will be maintained and fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activity. The system will incorporate a camera covering the entrance and inside of the store as well as a camera covering the front exterior of the premise and this will be capable of providing an image which is regarded as 'identification standard.' Should the cctv suffer failure the police will be informed and system repaired in 48 hours.

The premise shall keep and maintain an Incident/Refusals book. This is to record any refusals of sale or incidents that occur at the premise.
