Decision	To agree and sign off the proposed approach as set out below for public consultation material on the council's draft leisure strategy.			
	To delegate authority to head of service with responsibility for Leisure in consultation with the cabinet member for leisure to agree the final on line documents.			
Reasons for decision	In line with the council's Public Engagement Charter we will be engaging with local residents and interested groups on the suite of documents that form the Council's Leisure strategy.			
	The Leisure strategy has been updated to take account of the new strategic site allocations and requires adoption before being considered as part of the evidence for the Local Plan Examination.			
	An online public consultation exercise is programmed to commence on Monday 9 April 2018 for a four week period to raise awareness of the suite of draft documents and provide an opportunity for the wider community to feedback before adoption.			
	A large number of key stakeholders have already been consulted throughout the process including National Governing Bodies, Sport England and local clubs.			
	The findings of the engagement will be reviewed and considered by the leisure team and any recommendations for change be put to cabinet meeting for adoption.			

Alternative options rejected	The charter commits the council to consult on changes to policy. An online survey is considered the most suitable methodology for general public consultation and therefore other approaches have not been investigated.

Financial implications	The public consultation exercise costs will be funded from the councils public engagement revenue budget at £5,000 for MEL Research.
