

Record of Cabinet portfolio member decision

The award will be subject to the following grant conditions in addition to the standard conditions for all grants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Evidence of landlord consent for the project is provided to the grant officer before commencement of work. – Consultation on the choice and range of equipment is carried out with at least 20 of the young people in the community and the results are submitted to the grants officer. – A satisfactory post installation inspection report must be provided from a registered member of the Register of Play Inspectors International (RPiI), details can be found on the RPiI website: www.playinspectors.com. • the application from Garsington Sport and Social Club 46.15 per cent of the £26,000 estimated scheme costs up to a maximum of £12,000 towards the improvements to the kitchen and toilets and re-roofing of the building, all as detailed in the application and that the award be subject to the following grant conditions in addition to the standard conditions for all grants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – That any claims for the grant are signed by two other trustees from the organisation and not the original named contact. – Confirmation from the applicant that all of the roof felt will be

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	<p>replaced and not just small sections.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the application from Moulsoford Parish Council 44.08 per cent of the £34,026 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £14,999 towards the play area improvements, all as detailed in the application and that the award be subject to the following grant conditions in addition to the standard conditions for all grants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – A satisfactory post installation inspection report must be provided from a registered member of the Register of Play Inspectors International (RPII), details can be found on the RPII website: www.playinspectors.com. • the application from Girl Guiding Oxfordshire 30.27 per cent of the £49,560 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £15,000 towards the new amenity block at Jubilee House, Stanton St John, all as detailed in the application. • the application from Cholsey Community Development Trust 20.00 per cent of the £27,818 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £5,564 towards the provision of general and stage curtains, all as detailed in the application. • the application from The Chiltern Centre for Disabled Children 60.00 per cent of the £24,827 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £14,896 towards the new kitchen, all as detailed in the application.
	<p>Reasons for recommending decision</p> <p>The applications have been evaluated under the award criteria agreed by cabinet on 13 February 2012.</p> <p>The amount of grant awarded is in line with previous allocations made by both the cabinet and the cabinet member for grants under delegated powers.</p> <p>The award can be funded from the 2013/14 delegated grants budget. The remaining budget allocated to delegated grants is £299,847 at the time of publishing this report.</p>
