Decision	The virement of the additional £65,000 allocated Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) budget for Wallingford Changing Places toilet project in South Oxfordshire, for the period 2024/25, from provisional budget into approved budget. This additional budget was recommended by the CIL working group in January 2024 and approved as part of the 24/25 budget by Council in February 2024.		
Reasons for decision	The project is now progressing and is on track to complete by 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2024, within the financial deadline stipulated by the Dept. Levelling Up, Housing & Communities. We need to draw down the additional £65,000 CIL that has been allocated as soon as possible, to allow us clear funds to complete the project.
