Decision	To move £200,000 allocated Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) budget for Thame Changing Places toilet facility project in South Oxfordshire for the period 2024/25, from provisional budget into approved budget. This budget was recommended by the CIL working group in January 2024 and approved as part of the 24/25 budget by Council in February 2024.
Reasons for decision	<p>The £200,000 was identified as a growth bid for 2024/25, to facilitate the delivery of a Changing Places disabled toilet facility within Market House, Thame, as well as refurbishment of the existing public conveniences which are no longer fit for purpose.</p> <p>We have now obtained planning consent (ref: P24/S0622/FUL), with our proposed drawings for the Changing Places facility signed off by MDUK. We are now poised to progress these works and deliver them within FY 2024/25. Once the funding is in an approved status and within an assigned budget code, work on delivering these facilities can commence in full.</p> <p>Budget previously recommended and approved</p>
