

**PROPOSED CHANGES FOR SOUTH OXFORDSHIRE –
POLLING DISTRICT & POLLING PLACES REVIEW 2024**

General observations:

Cllr Sue Cooper agreed that any building used as a polling place should be fully accessible, and noted that alternative venues are best recommended by individuals familiar with the locality. Cllr Cooper agreed that a reduction in the number of voting places makes sense if the revision has sufficient capacity to accommodate the increase in electors. It was also noted that a reduction in the number of voting places where turnout is low would be a welcome change, and that availability of public transport should be considered for any recommended changes.
