Can references to “Cow’s Common” in Ewelme be changed to Cow Common?	Change to ‘Cow Common’ (in all documents i.e. assessment report, tables, strategy and appendix)
There is potential confusion between Cows Common (the common) and the pitches nearby. Could the strategy be amended to reflect this?	The report does make a distinction between the common and the recreation ground and we feel there is no change needed here.
PPS - Pitch 66 in appendix recreation is spelt wrong.	Spelling has been corrected.
LFAS – Abingdon Gymnastics Club is listed as being in the North however is located in Berinsfield (West) currently.	Amended references for Abingdon Gymnastics Club to West sub area.
Chalgrove MUGA has recently been refurbished by the Parish Council. Alternatively was the intention to mention it in the report to expand it to a bigger facility which would be helpful?	We have updated the strategy to include an ‘expansion’ to the MUGA recommendation. Our review shows that the MUGA had been upgraded in 2020, and therefore feel the recommendation to upgrade the MUGA in the short term (0-3 years) should remain, especially if the council aim to expand it. This would result improvements being done to the MUGA up to 7 years after the improvements.
The three playing fields in Chalgrove which are primarily used for football are in a poor state, and in need of investment beyond the Parish Council’s means. Inputs to the report were made about this situation following discussions with the Football association. As reported the village is losing players to other clubs outside the Chalgrove Parish because of the poor state of the pitches. Chalgrove has spent large sums of money in investing in its land for outdoor recreation.	No change required.  The PPS recommends improving the quality of the pitches at Chalgrove Recreation Ground (F42 in the strategy appendices).
The Chalgrove Skateboard park is in need of substantial investment from a safety and improvement point of view.	We have amended the assessment reports, that are large audit documents supporting the main report, to recognise that the skate park should be rated as “below average”. We have consequently added a recommendation to the strategy for improving the skatepark to ‘Chalgrove Recreation’.
Why does Chalgrove not feature in the 4 sub areas defined in the report.	No action.

	All areas of South Oxfordshire or Vale of White Horse are within a sub area. Chalgrove is in the West sub area.
Willowbrook Leisure Centre in Didcot is run by the Town Council, and they should be included in the lead partners section for improvements to this facility.	We have amended the strategy to add Didcot Town Council to lead partners in recommendations.
There are some erroneous references in the strategy "Vale golf", when this is the South Oxfordshire Strategy	We have amended the report to correct these references.
