Mr B Service	 Following consideration of grant applications to the community investment fund: to award Dorchester-on-Thames Parish Council 33.71 per cent of the £44,495 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £15,000 towards the creation of two multi use games areas, all as detailed in the application; to award John Hodges Trust for Harpsden Hall 33.36 per cent of the £33,576 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £11,200 towards the creation of a new cricket square, all as detailed in the application; to award Wallingford Methodist Church 34.37 per cent of the £23,279 estimated scheme costs, up to a maximum of £8,000 towards the instillation of a ventilation system, all as detailed in the application.
